The 2009 NACM Justice Achievement Award will be presented to the *Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Pilot Program* submitted by the First Judicial District of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, PA

Two additional projects, the *Conservator Account Monitoring, Preparation, and Electronic Reporting (CAMPER)*, submitted by the Second Judicial District, State of Minnesota and the *Packaging of Cases*, submitted by the Superior Court of California, County of Orange, will both be awarded Honorable Mention.

8. Project Title: Membership Dues Discount Program

Results: The Membership Committee developed criteria for a Membership Dues Discount Program which was adopted by the Board at the Mid-Year meeting in Portland, Oregon. Following the reprogramming of the membership database (anticipated July 2009), discounts will be applied as follows:

- a) a \$15.00 discount be established for new members;
- b) a \$10.00 discount be established if a member renews his or membership on line;
- c) a multi-year payment policy be established for members who wish to pay for up to 3 years of membership dues at a discount rate of \$15.00 per year; and
- d) a pilot program be established offering a discount for members who are both members of NACM and a state/regional association.
