

NACM HISTORIAN REPORT 2008-09 Report of Projects and Results

CHAIRPERSON: Lawrence G. Myers, Past President

During this fiscal year the following activities have taken place:

1. Due to NACM having a professional photographer at the 2009 Midyear Conference the Historian took a limited number (approximately 20) pictures at the Midyear Conference in Portland, Oregon March 8-11, 2009.
2. The pictures were inserted into protective sleeves and mailed to Linda Perkins, Association Services of the National Center for State Courts on March 24, 2009. The major focus of the pictures was on the opening reception, guests and speakers.
3. Picture CDs of the pictures were made and mailed to Linda Perkins, Association Services and Lorie Gomez, Publications on March 24, 2009 for possible use in future publications and/or on the web page.
4. Copies of specific photos were sent to: President Marcus Reinkensmeyer, Carl Baar, Ernest Friesen, Geoff Gallas, Tom Langhorne, Barry Mahoney and Maureen Conner.
5. As mention in the midyear report, thanks to the efforts of Janet Cornell and her staff the material on the early history of NATCA and NACA have been scanned and placed on separate DVDs on NATCA, NACA, The Merger Committee and the Transition Committee. These were to be shipped to the NACM Office (two copies) and a copy to the Historian with the original hard copies to be shipped to the Historian to be placed into Ultra-Pro hologram pages used for archival of material by April 1, 2009. Due to time constraints Janet has not been able to review the DVDs for completeness and all materials remain in Scottsdale, AZ.
6. A draft of an article on the history of NACM was submitted for publication on June 3, 2009.

ANTICIPATED ACTION IN THE INTERIM:

1. It is projected and a goal of the Historian that the above mentioned DVDs and hard copies will be received by September 1, 2009. The original documents will be placed into hologram pages that are acid free and no pvc and provide uv protection for archival and then placed into three ring notebooks for each section and mailed to Linda Perkins by the 1st of October, 2009.
2. It is the goal of the Historian that the draft of the sections to be placed on the web page under the tab for NATCA and the tab for NACA will be finalized and placed on the web page by October 1, 2009.

3. Follow-up on the information sent to Ms. Kelly McQueen, Office of the State Court Administrator, Georgia for placement as an update on Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia on the internet will be done with the goal of having the NACM material on Wikipedia updated by December 1, 2009.
